ABOUT THE ROLE:

[Broken Ground](#) is a podcast by the Southern Environmental Law Center. The podcast team's mission is to bring attention to important environmental stories in the South by focusing on the people who are most directly impacted by both bad and good environmental practices. We put an emphasis on highlighting voices that are often overlooked and/or marginalized and are committed to telling stories of people from all walks of life.

We're looking for a creative and energetic freelance producer who can begin immediately for a short-term 8-10 month contract period to help us weave a compelling story of 4 documentary-style episodes to air April 2020.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborate on ways to present series through four compelling episodes
- Conduct pre-interviews with subjects and sources
- Research and work with host in writing questions for field and studio interviews
- Find and incorporate relevant archival audio
- Record audio in the field and in studio.
- Participate in team listening of each episode to maintain sound style consistency and storyline cohesion.

REQUIRED SKILLS:

- Excellent skills recording audio in the field and studio
- Efficient multi-track editing, including mixing music and other elements – prefer experience and/or ability to work in Adobe Audition.
- Ability to meet deadlines
- Strong communication skills, both written and oral

OTHER THINGS TO KNOW:

- Position requires a willingness to travel for stories among our states (South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia, Georgia, Alabama, Tennessee)
- Prefer a candidate who is based in North or South Carolina
- We are open to working with someone remotely as long as there is willingness to travel for field production.
